Standardized eOutcomes Template

- Standard handshake to hospital EHR systems
- Uses the new standard for health information exchange
- FHIR Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources
 Facilitates correct record linkages (NEMSIS UUID)
- Reduces costs for health information exchange

What does this mean for EMS Clinicians?

- Timely information regarding patient outcomes
- Timely patient outcome reporting



EMS clinicians will have real time feedback on their performance



• Currently, clinicians have to wait to get feedback on their performance

• With v3.5, clinicians will have real time feedback
